Artists In-Residence Retrospective**

“This is truly one of our most celebrated exhibits, as we reunite our talented Artists In-Residence” - James Bellis, Board President, Hiram Blauvelt Art Museum.

On Sunday, March 9, 2015, The Hiram Blauvelt Art Museum will feature the “Artists In-Residence Retrospective” exhibit, displaying works of five artists who have participated in the esteemed Artists-In Residence program at the Hiram Blauvelt Art Museum. Some of the works in the exhibit are part of the museum’s Permanent Collection, while other selections of works come to the museum on loan from galleries throughout the country. Visitors will get a chance to see wildlife art in various forms- from sculptures to oil paintings. Board President, James Bellis adds, “What is amazing about this exhibit is the candid ability to capture the range and growth of each artist and what inspires each artist to select its subject”.

The five talented artists, whose works will be on display include: Guy Combes, Dwayne Harty, Geordie Millar, Terry Miller, and Aaron Yount. Each artist captures wildlife art in a unique form. When an artist is selected to participate in the program, he or she will have the opportunity to explore various mediums-pushing their craft to limits they never knew they could reach. A great example of this range can be seen at the entrance of the museum, “Fides-et-Virtus, Bronze Monument by Aaron Yount, originally known for his paintings. Mr. Yount’s time at the museum as an Artists In-Residence, provided him with the time to work with some of the top sculptors in the field, honing a craft that compliments his paintings.

During the month of March, another treat for visitors will be the chance meeting of two of the five artists, Aaron Yount and Dwayne Harty who will be onsite at times for Q&A.
